#### For early elementary kids (approx. K4-2<sup>nd</sup>):

Print the page with the mosaic cross (numbered in each section). Provide each child a dice. Have the child roll the dice and then color an area with the corresponding number (just one section per roll). Continue until their cross is all colored in!

#### For older kids (approx. 3rd grade and up):

After hearing the sermon scripture read (John 11:1-45), read John 20:1-18. Record the answers to these questions:

What words or phrases are similar between the 2 sets of verses?

What feelings do you think were the same in these 2 events?

What do you think are the big differences between Lazarus' resurrection and Jesus' resurrection?

Why do you think Pastor Chris chose to preach about Lazarus' resurrection on Easter?

#### For any age:

Print the Easter Retell (cross and pictures). Color in the pictures.

<u>For those not using scissors</u>: Cut the pictures out in advance and label them on the back with the letter that matches the box where it should be glued. Then, they can tell the stories of Holy Week.

<u>For "scissor ready" kids</u>: Have them cut out each picture and glue them on the cross in order, retelling the stories of Holy Week as they go.
