COVID-19 Vaccine Clinic

Back in November of 2020, Madison Medical Affiliates began the process of signing up to be a COVID-19 vaccination site through the state of Wisconsin. There were many boxes that needed to be checked before the state would approve our application and we successfully completed all of them. On December 23rd, we received our first shipment of 300 vaccines. With that shipment, we were able to vaccinate our employees, our providers, and may first responders in our community. Through a partnership with the Milwaukee County Office of Emergency Management, we vaccinated numerous EMS personnel. Robert Whitaker, Fire/EMS Chief for the North Shore Fire/Rescue Department, had this to say in response to our efforts:

"On behalf of the North Shore Fire Department, I wanted to thank you and everyone at Madison Medical for allowing our staff to be vaccinated at your clinics. The process has been seamless and allowing our people access to the vaccine has reassured our providers that they can be protected."

Continuing our mission to serve the community, we received a shipment of 300 additional vaccines.
